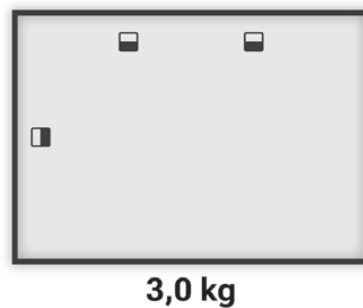
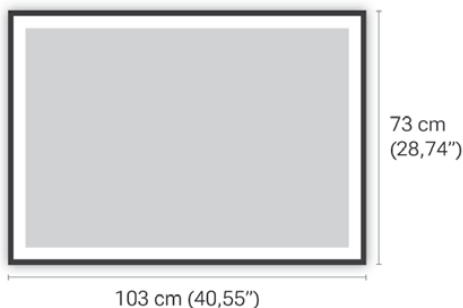


User Instructions (EN)

Product Description:

- **Product Name:** POSTER WITH FRAME
- **Manufacturer:** ARTTOR
- **Country of Manufacture:** Poland / Europe
- **Model:** P2BAA100x70, P2WAA100x70, P2NAA100x70
- **Poster dimensions:** 100 cm x 70 cm x 0,1 cm (39,37" x 27,56" x 0,04")
- **Frame dimensions:** 103 cm x 73cm x 1,5 cm (40,55" x 28,74" x 0,59")
- **Product Weight:** 3,0 kg
- **Production:** The poster is printed using safe, odorless, and durable inks with deep color saturation. It is printed on high whiteness paper with a weight of 200 g/m², prepared for independent mounting in the frame. The 2 cm wide frame is made of MDF, and the back of the poster is secured with a rigid 2 mm thick HDF board. The entire structure is lightweight and equipped with a hanger for easy installation. Each frame has an unbreakable sheet of clear acrylic plexiglass.



Package Contents:

- 1 x poster in a cardboard envelope with content information inside
- 1 x frame for mounting the poster
- 1 x installation instructions

The shipment consists of two components: the frame for mounting the poster and the cardboard envelope containing the poster. Both elements are joined with stretch tape, secured with bubble wrap, and placed in a shipping carton.

Usage Recommendations:

- Regularly check the condition of the fastenings to ensure safe hanging of the frame with the poster.
- Avoid installing in places exposed to high humidity, direct sunlight, or near heat-emitting devices.
- Clean the plexiglass only with a dry, soft cloth.
- **Posters in frames should be hung as intended:** On dry and solid surfaces, in places not exposed to drafts, high humidity, high temperatures, direct sunlight, and not above or near devices and equipment that emit heat.

Warnings and Safety Precautions: Before starting the installation, make sure you have the appropriate tools and can carry out the installation independently or with the help of an experienced person. Exercise caution when drilling holes to avoid damaging any electrical, plumbing, or other installations.

Technical and After-Purchase Support: If you have any questions, concerns, problems, or other issues related to the use and installation of the product, please contact the seller or the manufacturer directly.

Manufacturer's Warranty: The manufacturer strives to provide customers with a high-quality product. The manufacturer grants the buyer a 2-year warranty from the date of purchase. Under the warranty, the manufacturer is obliged to correct any defects resulting from production errors or material defects.

The manufacturer is not responsible for defects resulting from:

- Modifications or deviations from the described installation process made by the user
- Incorrect installation, use, or maintenance not in accordance with the purpose and instructions
- Mechanical damage occurring during installation and use



Do not store in rooms exposed to high humidity.



Attention, use the product according to its intended purpose. The product is not a toy and may contain small, protruding parts. Keep away from children.



The inks used during production meet environmental and health certifications, allowing the use of the product in indoor spaces.



The materials used for product packaging are made from recyclable materials, compliant with national environmental regulations.



Keep away from heat sources, in places not directly above or near heat-emitting devices and equipment. The product should be placed in areas not exposed to drafts.

Installation Instructions (EN)

Read the entire installation instructions carefully before proceeding. Attention! If you have any doubts or questions, contact the manufacturer to ensure that the installation process is safe and correct.

Safety Measures:

- Always wear protective gloves to protect your hands during installation.
- Use safety goggles to protect your eyes from potential debris.
- When installing a poster with two hangers, use a level to accurately mark the hanging points.
- Before starting the installation, make sure the chosen location is safe and properly prepared technically and in terms of durability. Ensure that installation work does not disturb any technical infrastructure of the wall, room, or building (e.g., structural, plumbing, electrical installations). The poster should only be hung on the hanger attached to the back of the frame. We do not take responsibility for any mounting methods chosen by the user on the wall.

Note: We are not responsible for the choice of the installation site or any damage caused by the installer during the installation.

Unpacking the Product

- Open the package by removing the cardboard staples.
- Remove the protective filling and carefully take out the contents wrapped in bubble wrap.
- Place the contents on a stable surface and gently remove the bubble wrap and stretch tape protecting the frame and poster.
- The poster is in a cardboard envelope with content information, and the frame is protected with a protective film.

Note: Do not use sharp tools for unpacking, as they may damage the poster or frame.

Preparing the Tools: Prepare a screwdriver, measuring tape, pencil, screws, hook, or other selected mounting system components. Regardless of the mounting technique, the manufacturer recommends the use of hooks as the safest solution for wall installation.

Choosing the Location: Select an appropriate location for the poster, ensuring it is clearly visible and adequately lit. Remember to check whether the wall material where you intend to hang the framed poster is strong enough to support its weight (the weight of the framed poster is provided in the product description).

Preparing the Wall Surface: The wall surface should be dry, smooth, and even. Make sure there are no contaminants or chips that could affect the stability of the installation.

Marking the Spot: Determine the appropriate height (usually at eye level). For frames with two hangers, use a level to mark the hanging points.

Drilling and Installing the Screw or Hook: Drill the hole according to the previously described safety measures and the information in the installation instructions. Remember, the responsibility for correctly drilling the hole and installing the hooks lies with the installer. We are not responsible for incorrectly performed work in this regard, so we recommend special caution and precision.

Mounting the Poster on the Wall: Ensure that the hook is appropriately chosen for the weight of the set and securely fastened to the wall to ensure safety and stability. We are not responsible for poorly prepared hooks, drilling, or other hanging systems, as well as improper surfaces on which the poster will be hung.

Important: Make sure the poster is mounted parallel to the wall. Proper installation ensures stability and an aesthetic appearance. The poster frame should not protrude or tilt relative to the wall surface.

Mounting the Poster in the Frame:

Preparing the Surface: Place the frame and poster on a flat, clean surface, allowing for easy handling of the elements without the risk of damage. Ensure that the table or surface is free of dust and debris that could scratch the frame or poster.

Checking Order Compliance: Open the envelope with the poster and check if the product matches the order. Set the poster aside in a safe place.

Preparing the Frame: Remove the protective film and cardboard corners from the frame. Place the frame face down. On the inner perimeter of the frame, there are black metal clips securing the backboard. Carefully lift the clips and remove the backboard with the hangers, placing it aside. Remove the white information card about the frame model and supplier, gaining access to the plexiglass.

Protecting the Plexiglass: The plexiglass is covered with a transparent protective film to prevent scratches. Peel off the film, starting from approximately 5 cm around the margin of the plexiglass. Then flip the plexiglass and place it back into the frame, ensuring the partially peeled film is on the front side of the frame. Remove the film completely without lifting or turning the frame.

Placing the Poster: Lay the poster face down on the plexiglass, noting where the top of the poster is located. Attach the backboard with the hangers, ensuring the hanger is at the top.

Securing the Backboard: Secure the backboard by pressing the metal clips around the inner perimeter of the frame. The clips should be pressed firmly to ensure a good fit with the backboard and frame.

Hangers: Gently tilt the hangers for mounting to allow placement on the hook or other applied mounting element.

Finally, remove the last layer of protective film from the front of the plexiglass and hang the framed poster in the chosen spot.

Responsibility: The person performing the installation should have knowledge and skills in the use of tools. Installation is done at the user's own risk. If the installer lacks experience, they should consult someone who can safely assist in the product installation.
